

C & Group Show notes



RASS

Two classes (females and males)

The top 4 unqualified horses within the top 4 in each class will qualify.

The qualification will not pass lower than fourth place.

The list of qualified horses will be updated on to the Facebook page and website as qualified horses are confirmed by secretaries and cards are received.

Classes are open to all competitors with Purebred AHS registered Arab open or novice/restricted.

No judge ride. Class judged from the floor by TWO judges, using points sheets - downloaded from the RASS website.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR SHOWS

Thank you for consideration of holding classes RIDDEN ARABIAN STAR SERIES (RASS) at your show.

Please take a moment to read the following conditions.

Shows wishing to hold RASS classes must agree to the following conditions.

1. Shows wishing to hold the RASS classes must pay a fee of £50 to RASS - payment details are listed below.

2. Classes must be judged on a points system by two judges. FROM THE FLOOR.

3. The type/conformation judge must be on the AHS panel judge list

The ride judge can be from ANY ridden panel, BUT DOES NOT RIDE.

4. Points will be awarded out of a maximum of:-

50 points for performance/show/way of going.

25 points for conformation

25 points for type

Horses MUST be stripped for conformation stage.

5. THE RIDE JUDGE DOES NOT RIDE EXHIBITS.

Instead each exhibit performs a set show which has been decided upon by the ride judge and is suitable to be performed by ridden horses of open standard. There is no initial pull-in. Exhibits stand in line in any order.

6. Two classes to be held. Split by sex. One male one female class.

The show is responsible for rosettes for the classes.

The Star Series will supply qualifier rosettes for the two qualifiers.

Only 4 unqualified horses will qualify, the qualification does not pass lower than 4th place. DO NOT GIVE QUALIFIER ROSETTES TO NON QUALIFYING HORSES

7. Please inform RASS of the number of classes you are holding to make sure you receive the correct number of qualifying rosettes. 3 classes may only be held if 6 or more stallions are entered.

8. Points MUST be displayed in the show office after each class for exhibitors to view.

9. Class mark sheets and conformation of qualified horses along with all entered horses should be posted to the Facebook page.

10. Judges are encouraged to use the full range of the marks they have at their disposal. The top five horses should all be clearly defined within their placings within the class. PLEASE MAKE YOUR JUDGES AWARE OF THIS.

Clear and concise marking will help exhibitors learn from the results they achieve from the marks they are awarded both in type and conformation and ride/show.

11. As points are to be added we would ask you to supply a calculator to your steward so points may be correctly checked before places are announced AS MISTAKES CANNOT BE RECTIFIED AFTERWARDS.
Marks sheets are available to download from the RASS website.

12. Only the top 8 horses should be pulled into placings.

13. Shows will not automatically receive classes in 2018
Should you wish to apply for 2018 Classes please do so in writing to the RASS committee.

14. CLASSES CANNOT CARRY THE NAME OF ANY SPONSOR.

All schedules and catalogues of qualifying shows must state the following:

RIDDEN ARABIAN STAR SERIES

This is a qualifying show for the Ridden Arabian Star Series (RASS).

The highest 4 previously unqualified horses from within the first four in each RASS class will qualify to enter the Championship class at the finals.

Classes are open to ridden Pure Bred Arabians over 4 years of age which are registered in the correct Arab Horse Society stud book. The highest placed previously unqualified horses within the top four placings with a current 2018 qualification will qualify for the finals.

No qualification for the Series will be passed down in the event of a qualified exhibit withdrawing for any reason.

Each horse wishing to qualify entering the class must have a RASS card which must be signed by the judge at the time of qualification in the ring.

Cards may not be brought into the ring after the commencement of the class.

Cards must be purchased a minimum of 7 days before competing in a RASS qualifier.

Qualification cannot be done retrospectively.

Horses must be registered in the name of the owner with the AHS. Exhibitor and Rider must be members of the AHS.

Non ECAHO in hand classes for 4 years old and over Purebred Arabians

Two classes (females and males)

The top four unqualified horses in each class will qualify.

The qualification will not pass lower than Fourth place.

Classes are open to all competitors with Purebred AHS registered Arab 4 years old and over.

Please take a moment to read the following conditions.

Shows wishing to hold RASS ALL STARS classes must agree to the following conditions.

1. Shows wishing to hold the ALL STARS and any other RASS classes must pay a fee of £50

2. Classes to be judged on comparative system.

3. The judge/Judges must be AHS panel judges

4. Two classes to be held. Split by sex. One male one female class. The show is responsible for rosettes for the classes. The Star Series will supply qualifier rosettes for the 4 qualified horses

FOUR unqualified horses will qualify, the qualification does not pass lower than 4th place. Do not give rosettes to horses WITHOUT qualifying cards.

5. Please inform of the number of classes you are holding to make sure you receive the correct number of qualifying rosettes. 3 classes may only be held if 6 or more stallions are entered.

7. Shows will not automatically receive classes in 2018

RASS ALL STARS and JUNIOR ALL STARS

This is a qualifying show for the RASS ALL STARS

The highest FOUR previously unqualified horses from within the first FOUR places in each RASS ALL STARS class will qualify to enter the Championship finals class.

Open to Pure Bred Arabians over 4 years of age which are registered in the correct Arab Horse Society Stud Book.

The highest placed previously unqualified horses within the top FOUR placings with a current qualification card will qualify for the finals.

No qualification for the Series will be passed down in the event of a qualified exhibit withdrawing for any reason.

Each horse wishing to qualify by entering the class must have a RASS card which must be signed by the judge in the ring.

Cards may not be brought into the ring after the commencement of the class.

Qualification cannot be gained retrospectively.

Horses are required to stand in a more relaxed pose than exhibited in ECAHO classes.

Bagging is not allowed.

Stallions must be bitted.

It is the responsibility of exhibitors to check full details and rules available at www.riddenarabianstarseries.co.uk

Qualified exhibitors must return the signed card to the RASS committee within 10 days of qualification for the championship class as indicated on the card if they wish to participate in the championship class.

CARE - Career after racing or endurance

A ridden class for ex race purebred Arabian horses and ex or currently competing endurance purebreds.
There is no judge ride. Classes are judged comparatively with one or two judges.

Eligibility for CARE classes: Racers - to have been in training at a racing trainers yard for a minimum of 2 months; Endurance - to have competed or currently competing at any level in endurance for at least one season.

Horses DO NOT need to purchase a RASS card to compete in CARE classes, however if they wish to be included into the RASS CARE points scheme they must purchase a card.

Eligible horses' RASS cards will be marked as CARE

Classes are open to all competitors with Purebred AHS registered Arab open or novice/restricted.
